Distillers in Friuli since 1897

The Nonino family can trace their involvement in the production of Grappa to 1897. In 1973, Benito and Giannola Nonino revolutionised the method of producing and marketing Grappa by creating for the first time a single varietal style, known as Monovitigno Nonino, distilling the pomace of the Picolit grape on its own.

The Nonino family uses only the artisanal batch distillation stills created by Benito, which produce small quantities of outstanding quality distillate, a million miles away in aroma and flavour from those Grappa's produced by the industrial, continuous method.
